This document is meant to direct schools and district administrators in continuing education training for their Guardian Program participants. The goal of the CE training is to equip the participants with the highest level of skills in order to properly protect the children in their care. Following this protocol ensures the administrators and stakeholders have the most effective liability mitigation tool possible.

This training protocol is an 80-hour course list with a 40-hour per fiscal year requirement. Administrators have the option of which courses the participants attend per fiscal year.

*Recommended Pre-requisite:Guardian Program Participants must have successfully completed the GSFT School Safety Certification Course. In the first fiscal year, the 16-hour course can count toward the 40-hour requirement.
