CURRICULUM & STANDARDS



1 WRITTEN PRE-TEST

The DPS pre-exam covers basic handgun regulations and laws — similar to the test taken during your LTC/CHL course. Review the statutes in the *Texas License to Carry a Handgun Laws (LTC-16)*.

2 FINAL WRITTEN TEST

A final exam based on the information covered during the classroom portion of the course.

3 ACTIVE-SHOOTER SIMULATIONS

Students participate in practical, force-on-force exercises built to be as close to reality as possible. Participants are armed with state-of-the-art modified Glock 17s or 19s loaded with *Ultimate Training Munitions™ 9mm Man Marker Rounds (MMR™)* — military-grade training ammunition that fires real projectiles safely. Scenarios incorporate live role-players, and “threats” will return fire. Students must react correctly using the techniques taught.

4 LTC PRE-QUALIFICATION

Students must complete the DPS LTC live-fire proficiency at a 90% accuracy rating — a score of **225 out of 250**. Targets are provided. **Students scoring under 225 are not legally permitted to continue, and there is no second attempt during the course.**

5 SHOOTING UNDER DURESS

DPS regulations limit advance disclosure of the course of fire. In general, students fire approximately 100 rounds under duress at hostage targets — moving and shooting, conducting emergency reloads, at distances ranging from 3 to 50 yards.
